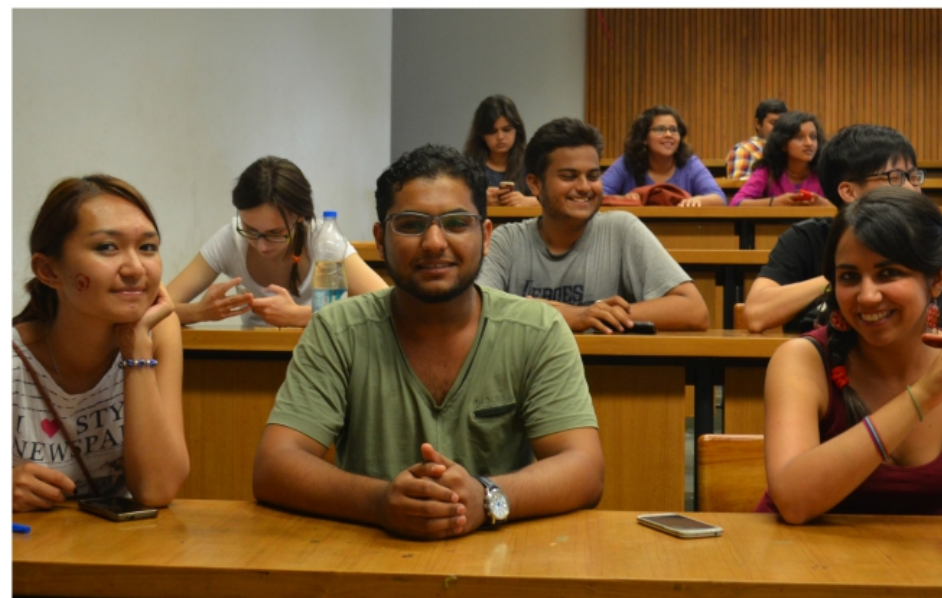

In addition, team up with students and faculties from the different diversity and win exciting prizes. A lot of adventure and surprises are waiting for you!

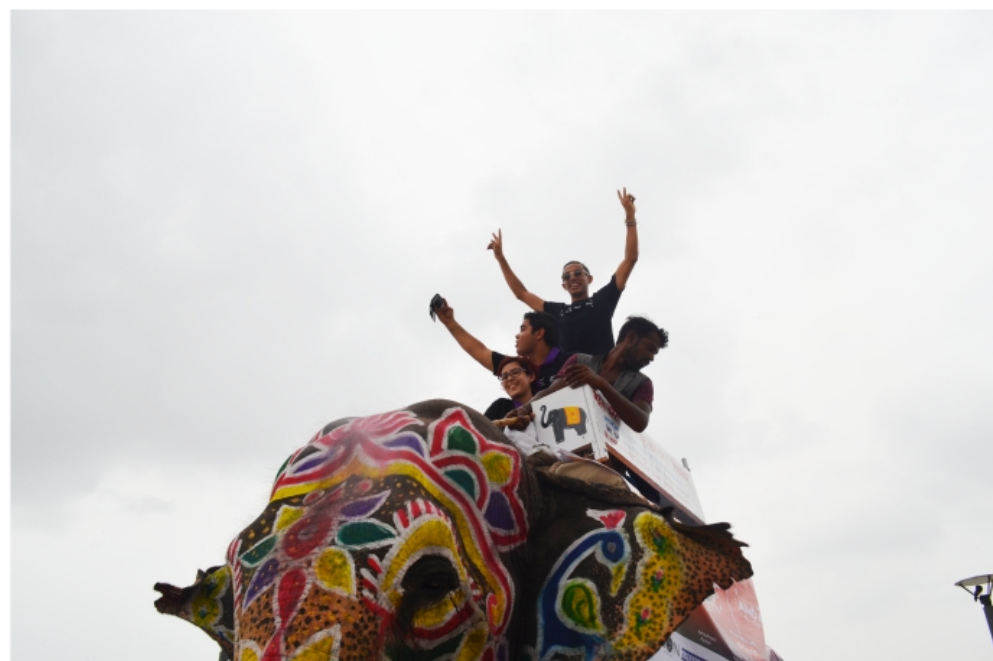


INDIA DAY

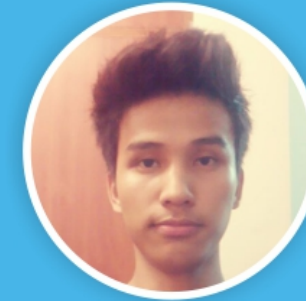

ABOUT GANDHINAGAR

The new capital city was planned by two Indian planners, H.K. Mewada, educated at Cornell University and Prakash M Apte. Both Mewada and Apte had worked as a trainee in the Chandigarh Project in 1950s.

The city has developed in four distinct phases:

Phase 1

After the city's infrastructure was completed in 1970, and until 1980, it was known as "Gandhian City", since it was based on Gandhi's concepts and principles.

Phase 2

Between 1980 and 1990, a time of low pollution, it was known as "Unpolluted City".

Phase 3

After 1990, many trees were planted, and the city became the "Green City".

Phase 4

In 2002, Gujarat's Chief Minister, Narendra Modi, proposed a new, triple focus for the city: it should be green, It should utilize solar energy, and it should be cosmopolitan.
