
Energy, Industry 4.0 & Internationalization are three important distinctive areas in the year 2020-21 by the university to it vision, priority and thrust

Laser Metal 3D Printing Facility at the University is another such initiative as a part of Atmanirbhar Bharat initiative in energy Sector.



Internationalization at the University

The University has more than 280 full-time students from approx. 38 no. of different countries. The University is the partner of the Study in India (SII) initiative of Govt. of India and Study in Gujarat initiative of Govt. of Gujarat. The University facilitates a one to two months International Exchange Program (IEP) since 2010 with the Partner foreign Universities every year. IEP is designed for the students to get global exposure academically, and culturally. Till now, 30 (IEPs) have been conducted and total of 740 students & 48 Faculty members have been benefitted through this initiative. Study in



India Program (SIP) is a 2-6 weeks module-based short-term program that primarily caters to foreign students & faculties. The program is interdisciplinary, demonstratingIndian religions and cultures. Till now, 09 SIPs have been conducted, and 100+ students & 11 Faculty Members got benefitted through this initiative.





The University has so far conducted 16 exchange/abroad program and total 27 students have been benefitted from it .Through the travel grant policy, 950+ students have presented papers in countries like the UK, Spain, Singapore, Malaysia, Dubai, USA, Bahrain, China, Sweden, Oman, Egypt, Canada, Thailand, Sri Lanka, Germany, etc. <u>Outcome</u>, increased visibility of the University, Enhancing Students' Profile, Short term Exposure to International Education & Research System, Developing long term interest for Semester Abroad, Masters' abroad, etc. Total No. of Beneficiaries till now: 15+
