
## BASIC STRUCTURE OF THE CONSTITUTION

- 1951 Shankari Prasad case FRs amendable
- 1967 Golaknath case FRs NOT amendable
- 1973 Kesavananda Bharathi case FRs amendable but, basic structure/features
- 1980 Minerva mills case basic structure/features
- 1981 Waman Rao case adhered to basic structure/features and applicable to constitutional amendments after 1973
- S. Court YET to define basic structure/features


