Legislative Process

Minister/Private Member \leftarrow Introduction \rightarrow R. Sabha/ L.Sabha

- 1. Notice of a Bill 7 days notice; if Speaker allows shorter
- 2. Circulation of Bill reach 2 days before that Bill business
- 3. A. 1st Reading: The motion for leave to introduce a Bill/Laying on the Table of the House of the bill

Leave to introduce - oppose (by notice) - Voting - Introduction of Bill




- 3. B. 1st Reading: Publication in Gazette Introduction of Bill
- 4. Reference of Bill to Dept. Related Standing Committees 3 months Report 4A. Comprehensive Bill or 4B. Consideration stage amendments
- 5. 2nd Reading: 1st stage: discussion on the principles and provisions of the bill, amendments moved
- 1st stage: 1. Taken to consideration
 - 2. Select Committee of the House/ Joint Committee opinion, expert evidence
 - 3. Opinion including petitions on bills (Public views)
- 2nd stage: clause-by-clause consideration, amendments vote of the House
