Publications, Journals, Books and Articles Published

The unique Research Information Management Systems (RIMS) of PDPU and its benefit in facilitating R&D program was described.

Research and development activity of the School of Petroleum Technology was described in detail by the school director Dr.Anirbid Sircar

Dr.H.B.Raghvendra gave a detailed account of the R&D Activities of the School of Technology.

The Chemical Engg.department discussed about the research initiatives in carbon capture and bio-fuel.

Details of totalpatents and publication from Solar Resear5ch Centre was presented Dr.Nigam Dave, Director SLS presented detailed account of research and development in the School of Liberal Studies. He also mentioned about the achievement of students and faculties for the year 2016-2017. Community development programs which is a unique initiative by SLS was also discussed.

Dr.C.Gopalakrishnan, I/c Director SPM talked about the PhD program, research projects and publications. He also mentioned that SPM has started with the Journal of Energy and Management.

Dr.N.Saibaba suggested that partnership could be done with BARC, ICGAR,RRCAT, NFC for funding on projects. He also shared that PDPU is getting Sewage Sludge Hygienisation in collaboration with BARC.

Mr.S.S.Agarkar shared that

- (b) Towards home grown innovation and automation project
- (c) Welding techniques and automation

DG also mentioned here that PDPU will be establishing tinkering labs 'TodFod Jod' and talked about E-Yantra.

Dr.A.V.Chainulu suggested leveraging the CSR funds and organize skill development programs in PDPU. He also mentioned that PDPU should use its existing CoEs for high end services like testing.

Mr.G.N.Rao suggested that PDPU should become nodal knowledge centre for

recycling the plastic waste generated in the state. PDPU should also work towards

research on river linking and dam.

Prof.T.V.Rao appreciate the research efforts of PDPU and gave suggestions on

inculcating research attitude among faculties and students. Faculty evaluation through

balancing teaching and research activities. Interdisciplinary research work and human

attitude research.

Dr.S.K.Ghosh suggested research on radiation technologies and on Deuterium-depleted

water. He also proposed interdepartmental collaboration.

Dr. Amitava Das advised to leverage the energy program and include Bio-Mass energy

and waste management studies in order to make the students more employable.

Prof. Chaitanyamoy Ganguly in his final comments opined the need of more funding

by the Private sector and the necessity of research on 'FEW' Concept: Food security,

Energy conservation, water and waste management.
